Renew You-PHP hosted our second annual Renew You online series with approximately 200 registered. This limited series featured topics including Stigma, The Family Effect, Grief, and Hope, once every week for a month. CBHN-PHP continues to plan and work with our Children's Behavioral Health Network partners. We joined our partners to host another virtual conference providing speakers and funding.

Co-Hosted Oklahoma's first National Federation of Families Conference. PHP is one of only two state affiliates for the National Family Federations of Families, and we were very fortunate to serve as a co-host for their first 4-day National conference in Oklahoma. 755 people from 42 states attended. Started a Roundtable for partners-We partnered with the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) to create a Roundtable with our partners. This group is currently working to set up priorities concerning substance use disorder for the next few months. Attendance for these Roundtable meetings includes 10 to 15 participants. Our partners include Peaceful Family Oklahoma, Teen Recovery Solutions, Santa Fe Southwest, ODMHSAS, OMMA, and representatives from other state agencies and organizations. We also continue to serve on local and state advisory teams and committees.
